### Masonic Philosophy

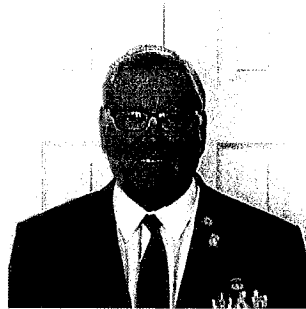
